



SURVIVAL OF THE RESILIENT Disruption | Impact | Response

In an era marked by constant upheaval—from global crises and cyber threats to regulatory shifts and climate events—disruption is inevitable. Its impacts are far-reaching, causing operational breakdowns, financial strain, and strategic uncertainty. In this context, resilience is the defining trait that enables organisations not only to withstand shocks but to emerge stronger.

Resilience involves anticipating risks, absorbing shocks, adapting swiftly, and maintaining continuity. It spans five key dimensions: absorption, recoverability, adaptability, continuity, and learning. Resilient organisations are proactive, embedding resilience into their core operations and culture rather than treating it as an afterthought.

There are various response pathways to disruption. Some organisations capitalise by innovating, others realign processes, repurpose assets, or retrench to preserve core functions. A resilient response typically includes strategic agility, strong communication, empowered teams, and data-driven decision-making.
